Directions

The ride will begin and end at Lake of the Woods County Park in Mahomet, Illinois.

From I-74, take exit #174. Proceed north to first stop sign (2250N — Casey's is on the right-hand corner); turn left. Proceed to the next stop sign (Lake of the Woods Road); turn left and drive up the hill. The entrance to Lake of the Woods Park will be on your right. Signs in the park will direct you to the registration pavilion **on the right**, (changed from 2007).

Registration

Check-in for both pre-registered riders and day-of-ride registration opens at 7:30 a.m. and closes at 10 a.m. Those planning to ride the 65-mile route should plan to begin riding by 8:30 am.
